

## TUTBURY PARISH COUNCIL

A meeting of the Strategic Planning Committee of the Parish Council was held in the Charity Office, Duke Street, Tutbury on Monday 4 November 2013.

### 1.0 APOLOGIES

Apologies were received from Cllrs G Wright and Ms M Guest

### 2.0 CONSIDERATION OF THE PARISH COUNCIL'S RESPONSE TO ESBC'S CONSULTATION ON THE PRE-SUBMISSION LOCAL PLAN

2.1 Cllr W Crossley reviewed the local plan documentation received from the Borough Council. It had been stipulated that in the reply to the consultation, comments had to be confined to legal compliance and soundness; responses were required by 29 November 2013.

2.2 In the plans for Tutbury, there was an error on the boundary depicting the Burton road site and a wrong annotation of a playing field in Cormill Lane, both of which needed to be corrected.

2.3 The chairman had examined the plan documents and maps and in order to make a comparison with the preferred option edition of the plan and to identify areas of concern affecting the parish and the wider vicinity.

2.4 Members discussed various aspects of the policies in the plan and raised concerns on a number of matters including:

- The number of houses being proposed and how they were derived
- The impact of proposed development on the transport network
- How the public and other services were to be provided to meet the needs of the increased population.

2.4 It was felt that the Parish Council should be represented at the public examination stage of the plan which was to be held by a government appointed inspector

2.5 It was agreed to refer consideration of the plan to the November meeting of the Parish Council
