### Planning Application P2016/01107.

Flexible generation facility with a capacity of approximately 10 MW. Facility will generate electricity to the National Grid at times of peak demand to ensure a secure supply of electricity to the local area.

#### Location

The proposed site is situated off Burton Road approx. 230m from Doves Keep Housing Development, next to Land End Farm and is sited on the land of New Farm that lies between Cornmill Lane and Burton Road. The access road is off Burton road on the opposite side to Dove Keeps housing developmententrance.

### Plan details.

- Diesel Storage tank 10.5m x 2mx2.5m which contains 52.5 cubic metres of diesel.

- Electric connection from the adjacent solar farm on Burton Road.

The site will be used for a maximum of 200 hours annually. Times of operation will be a maximum of 2 hours operation between the hours of 07.00-14.00 and 16.30-22.00. Approximate deliveries of diesel 2-3 a month.
